## Golden Jubilee Park – Latest News!



The Park has been de-stoned, rolled and seeded. Boundary fencing has been erected around the car parking/netball court area and mesh has been laid that the grass will grow through. This will provide for 33 parking spaces including 2 for disabled people.

There is still some work to be done in respect of phase 1 of the development and arrangements are in hand to complete the perimeter path.

The Council will review its plans and decide what to include in phase 2 of this project very soon and you will be informed via this Newsletter.

Chester City Council has been asked to include the Park, in a Bylaw it is making, as an alcohol free area.

## Planning Applications

The Council is always interested to know the views of residents regarding Planning Applications. Do tell us what you think, either by providing the Clerk with a copy of any correspondence you have sent to Chester City Council, or by informing her by telephone or email. You are also very welcome to come to the Planning Committee meetings where you can have the opportunity to air your views! Details of these meetings are always posted on the Council's notice boards.

## When does the Council Meet?

The Council meets generally on the first Monday of the month. Notices are displayed on the Council's notice boards and website. Agendas for the Council meetings are put on deposit in the Co-op stores and posted on the Council's website ([www.saughall.gov.uk](http://www.saughall.gov.uk)). Any resident on the Electoral Roll of Saughall and Shotwick Park is welcome to attend.

Before the meeting actually begins some time is set aside for members of the public to address the Council on matters of concern and ask questions so long as they have given the Clerk five clear working days notice of their intention to do so. You are free to leave at anytime. (You do not have to sit through the whole meeting unless you want to.)

## Primary School Co-ordinated Admission Arrangements



All applications from parents and carers must be made on the Cheshire County Council Application Form and submitted by the closing date of **14 January** in the School year of your child's admission to the infant school. Application forms will be available from 14 September in the year preceding your child's admission year. (This date also applies to the junior school) You can state preference(s) for up to three schools, which must be placed in rank order, and give reasons for each preference.

The Cheshire Local Education Authority (LEA) prepares allocations of places to the two Saughall schools on the basis of equal preferences. All preferences listed by parents are considered without reference to the ranking. Where a pupil can potentially be allocated more than one place, the place ranked highest by the parents or carers will be offered.

On **14 March** the LEA will post offer letters by second class post to all parents and carers who have expressed a preference for both Saughall

schools. Where online applications have been received, the parent or carer making the online application can logon to their online account on 14 March to view the school place offered and can also request to receive their offer by email. Where requested, the email offer will be sent on 14 March.

## Trees

Mrs Helen Cakebread, as Parish Tree Warden, has produced a report on the trees both in the Park and in the village streets. She has recommended that some maintenance is carried out e.g. herbicide spraying and strimming and All Cheshire Garden Services is in the process of doing this at a total cost of £520.

## Thoughtless Parking

Problems are arising from cars being parked on pavements, resulting in the elderly and disabled being unable to pass with safety. This is happening in many places, but particularly in the area of The Ridings School at collection time. Dropped curbs which have been introduced to help the disabled, are being blocked by parked cars. Please ensure that you are not putting the elderly at risk.

## Beware of Bogus Callers

There have been an increasing number of reports about bogus callers operating in the Saughall area. Always ask to see any official's ID and ring the company he/she purports to represent, to check, if you are at all suspicious. It is better to be safe than sorry!

## Limit Your Litter

Please ensure that your litter bags are tied up tightly when put out for collection by the Council. There are occasions when the bags come open and rubbish is then scattered about by the wind or vermin.



## The Golden Rules of Dog Ownership



The Council once again requests dog owners to clean up after their pets. **It is the duty of every responsible dog owner to clear up after their dogs.** There is an automatic fine of £50 (under the Dogs Fouling of Land Act 1996) or prosecution with fines of up to £1,000 for the offence of dog fouling in public areas.

**YOU ARE NOT ALLOWED TO EXERCISE YOUR DOG IN THE GOLDEN JUBILEE PARK, NOR ARE YOU ALLOWED TO TAKE IT IN TO THE PLAY AREA WHEN YOU ENTER WITH YOUR CHILDREN.**

Complaints about dog fouling have been received from all areas of the village.
